

## Pupil Premium Allocation September 2019 to September 2020

Melsonby Methodist Primary School was allocated <b>£770</b> for academic year <b>September 2016</b> to <b>September 2017</b> . Pupil Premium allows us to provide a range of opportunities to enhance learning thus positively impacting on pupils' experiences at school and beyond. This is how the money was used.

As of September 2017 the school had no Pupil Premium pupils. £135.00 remained unspent but acted as a contingency for any in-year Pupil Premium admissions.

However in September 2019 we found out two pupils were eligible for the funding and we are currently awaiting the funding.

These identified pupils do not need academic support but do need financial support to attend school trips, residential visits and other cost related activities. Pupil Premium will be used to support these pupils and if needed the funding would be used to support learning.
