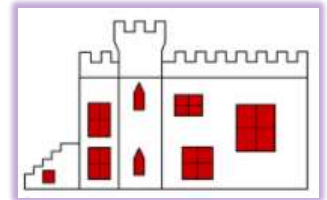

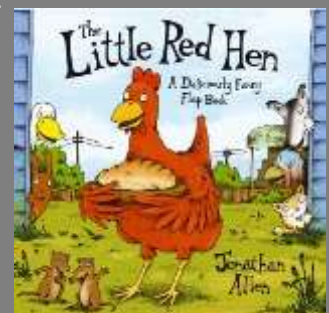

Please can we remind everyone that Parent Pay accounts for lunches and wrap around care must be kept in credit.

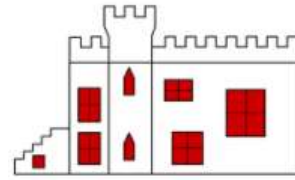
