It was such a pleasure to see the children's enthusiasm and resilience towards this event. And yet another great opportunity for the children in our Federation to come together.

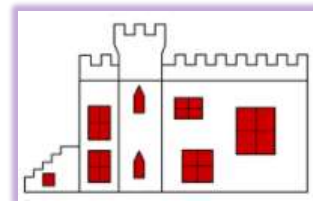
We hope that you all enjoy any bonfire night celebrations that you may be attending and stay safe during these.

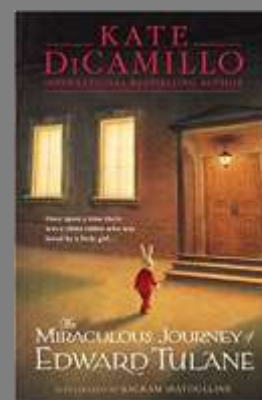

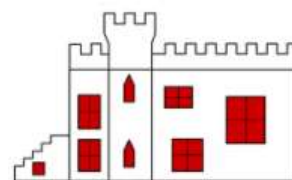
