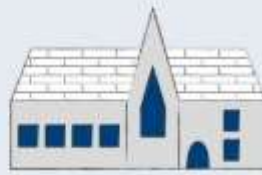
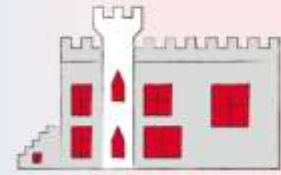

To launch our updated logo, the school will pay for one new jumper or cardigan per child for September. We will gather information on size orders from you shortly.

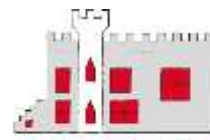
