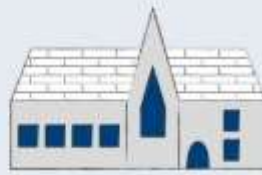
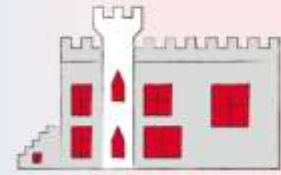

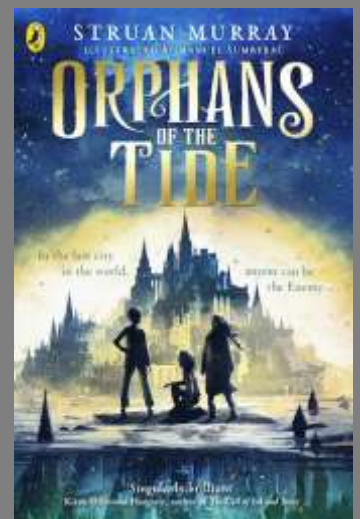
As part of our learning about online safety, we would love for you to use this quiz to prompt discussions with the children at home about the safe use of the internet.
